CMO is a timed event covering 5 to 15 miles on horseback. Riders attempt to find 5-10 markers using a map (provided) and compass. Riders may compete as individuals or teams. There will be a pre-ride clinic and practice session if needed before the ride. You will need an orienteering compass (example: Silva 7), available at many camping and discount stores. A fun sport for all ages and disciplines.

DIRECTIONS: FROM I-75 IN KY – From Interstate 75 into Tennessee: Take Exit 141 (Oneida/Huntsville & Hwy. 63 Exit). Take Hwy. 63 to a traffic light on Hwy. 27. Go south on 27 to Elgin, where you will turn right onto Hwy. 52. Take Hwy. 52 to a 4-way stop in Allardt. At the 4-way stop, go straight to a stop sign at Hwy. 127. Turn left onto Hwy. 127 for a couple of miles, and we are on the right.

FROM I-40 – From Interstate 40 in Tennessee: Take Exit 317 (Crossville/Jamestown & Hwy. 127 exit). Go north on Hwy. 127 for 28 miles. We are on the left.

FACILITIES: The East Fork Stables Campground is divided into five alphabetical sections. Each section is a little different to accommodate a variety of camping styles. Rates do not include taxes, stall rental for horses or stall cleaning fees. Ride managers will be in Campground D. This area has Water and Electric, and permanent picket lines. Stalls are also available.

IMPORTANT INFO FROM EAST FORK: July is customer appreciation month and with signed East Fork Stables liability waiver, current Coggins, and balance paid 14 days prior to arrival all campsites and cabins are 25% off. Those forms can be snail mail or emailed. All reservations are made by phone at 931-879-1176 and a deposit of roughly 25% of total reservation is required when reservation is made.
