CMO is a timed event covering 5 to 15 miles on horseback. Riders attempt to find 5-10 markers using a map (provided) and compass. Riders may compete as individuals or teams. There will be a pre-ride clinic and practice session if needed before the ride. You will need an orienteering compass (example: Silva 7), available at many camping and discount stores. A fun sport for all ages and disciplines.

FACILITIES: There are 10 equestrian campsites with water and electric hookups. Sites are level and most are shaded. Hitching rails are provided for horses. Site #46 is ADA-compliant. A permanent bathhouse is available.

IMPORTANT INFO: Double-up on sites is allowed. Please reserve accordingly when you call. Trails are mostly dirt with some lake rock and rock in improvement areas. Mud should also be expected on these trails. ***Sunday Checkout is 1 pm, Due to this Friday we will offer both Long and Short courses, Sunday SHORT course ONLY.
