



ZUMBRO BOTTOMS CMO

May 30 and 31, 2026

CMO is a timed event covering 5 to 15 miles on horseback. Riders attempt to find 5-10 markers using a map and compass. Riders may compete as individuals or teams.
Long and short rides both days

WHERE: Zumbro Bottoms State Forest, West Camp

Directions to west camp: From Wabasha take HWY 60 west 12 miles, turn left on Co. 4 go 3 miles, to Co. 86 turn left and follow 2.5 miles.

REGISTRATION: Opens Friday at 7pm at the West Camp Pavilion, ride meeting at 7pm Friday. 8am Saturday and Sunday check-in trail briefing. Registration opens 8am-10:30am.

OUT TIMES: By sign up list (first-come, first-serve) list available during Friday ride meeting with times from 8:10am-11:30am Saturday and Sunday. Out times will be in 10 minute increments, one team per out time. All Riders must be out by 11:30am both days.

COURSES:

Short Course: 5 Objects

Long Course: 10 Objects

FEES: NACMO members \$10.00/day, junior members \$5.00/day (18 & under)

Non-members: \$15.00/day, juniors \$10/day (Includes insurance)

First Time Competitors: \$5/day (insurance only)

FACILITIES:

Ample primitive camping, \$22/night, pay ahead on the Yodel App

There is no cell service available in camp

Highlines available, portable pens allowed

Pit toilets, picnic tables and horse water hydrants available

Generators may be used during the day; quiet times are from 10 pm to 8 am

TRAILS: Combination of sand, rock, gravel and dirt. Shoes or boots are recommended. MN Horse Pass required.

POTLUCK: Saturday 6pm at the Pavilion. Carolina Pulled Pork & Buns provided by the hosts. Please bring a dish to pass and your own plates and utensils.
