PRE-RIDE MEETING AND DRAW @ 9:30 FIRST RIDER/TEAM OUT @ 10AM

RIDER/TEAMS WILL BE TIMED OUT AT 5 MINUTE INTERVALS

TEAM SIZE IS 6 RIDERS MAXIMUM

CMO IS A TIMED EVENT WHERE EITHER INDIVIDUALS OR TEAMS GO ON HORSEBACK AND USING A COMPASS AND MAP (PROVIDED) FIND OBJECTIVES (HIDDEN PLATES).

BRING YOUR OWN COMPASS, HORSE AND WATER

LONG COURSE CONSISTING OF 10 OBJECTIVES W/ RIBBONS THRU 6TH PLACE

SHORT COURSE CONSISTING OF 5 OBJECTIVES W/ RIBBONS THRU 3RD PLACE

Directions:

From southbound I-5 take exit 95, go west towards the Restaurant. Turn left on to Case Road SW. Go 4.1 miles. Parking is on the right.

From northbound I-5 take exit 88, go right onto old HWY 99 SW. Turn left onto Loganberry St SW, turn left onto 183rd Ave SW. turn right on Case Rd SW. Go 1.6 miles to parking on left. Watch for CMO directional plates off Case Road.

Clean-up and pack out all hay and manure. Leave a clean area.
