
East-West Indian Camp CMO in The Teanaway


formations, rivers, caves and many miles of lovely trails will be found on this CMO.

Indian Camp: Located along the middle fork of the Teanaway River, the Group Horse Camp offers campsites with picnic tables, and pit toilet. Stock water available a short walk away at the river only. Highline Poles in Group Camp. **Discovery Pass required.**

Directions: We will be using the NEW Group Camp area at Indian Camp. Watch for CMO Signs. Start at I-90 exit 85 (Cle Elum). Go east on SR-970 for 6.9 miles. Turn left on Teanaway Road. Go 7.3 miles. Turn left on West Fork Teanaway Road for .6 miles. Turn right on Middle Fork Teanaway Road. Go 3.9 miles (last mile will be unpaved). Turn right into Indian Camp campground.
